



## Ernest Shaver

January 22, 1936 - April 12, 2013

Ernest Lee Shaver, age 77, of Coldwater Circle in Myrtle Beach, died Friday, April 12, 2013 at Tidelands Community Hospice House.

Mr. Shaver was born in Charlotte, NC to the late Blanche and Lester Shaver. He was a US Air National Guard veteran. He retired as owner of CBS Printers and was a former employee of Dowd Press. Mr. Shaver taught Sunday school, had served as a Deacon and was currently a member of Bible Baptist. Mr. Shaver taught the homeless and was an avid fisherman. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Billy Joe Shaver, Jerry Mac Shaver; and sister, Marie Shaver.
