Esther Ann Jordan passed on to the promise of the Resurrection in Jesus Christ on November 17, 2012.

She was born April 13, 1928 in Waterbury, CT to James and Virginia (Flynn) Campbell.

Esther entered the Sisters of Mercy in Connecticut and took the name "Sister Brian". She taught in Catholic Schools in Fairfield, Bridgeport, Danbury, New Haven, Hartford, and Great Britain, CT.

Esther married Fred Jordan in 1972 and they moved to Cape Cod, MA. There she worked for the New England Telephone Co. and later substituted in the Mashpee School system.

They retired to Garden City in 1992. Her father and uncles had been career firemen and she joined them, becoming a volunteer dispatcher/greeter for the Murrells Inlet-Garden City Fire Department. The last ten years of her service she was supervisor of the volunteer greeters. There was nothing that warmed

Esther's heart more than being with "her boys". They, in turn, showed the same affection and loyalty to her.

Survivors include her husband, Fred Jordan; sister, Jean Concilio; brother in law, Robert (Maryanne); sisters in law, Pat Campbell, CT; Dorothy Barron, Kathleen Tozzi, Eileen Gaudet (Alvin) and Maureen Wicklund (Robert). She is also survived by several nieces and nephews in Connecticut. Esther is predeceased by her brother James, Francis, John and her sister Maebeth.
