Eugene E. "Gene" Nagele, age 92, passed away Thursday, January 9, 2020. Born May 2, 1927 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late William and Catherine Schaible Nagele.

Mr. Nagele joined the US Navy when he was 16. He served our grateful nation for 30 years, during WWII in the Pacific, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. Mr. Nagele retired as a Commander.
