Mrs. Evelyn "June" Blevin (nee Baldrige) died peacefully on July 1, 2016 in Conway, SC at the age of 98.

Mrs. Blevin was born on February 20, 1918 in Seaman, OH to Mr. and Mrs. Ormond Baldrige. She was the valedictorian of her high school class and subsequently graduated from Wilmington College with a Teacher's Diploma. She taught fourth grade at Elmwood School before she met and married James Blevin in 1941. She remained in education for over 50 years as a substitute teacher, mainly at Oakdale Elementary in Cincinnati, OH. Mrs. Blevin and her husband, Jim, loved to travel and visited all over the 48 contiguous United States.
