Faye received a certificate for Transliterator for the deaf in Fredericksburg, VA. She was an ENT nurse for 5 years in Fredericksburg and worked at the Spottsylvania County, Stafford Fredericksburg, Gallaudet University as Transliterator for 15 years. Her interest were varied and her talents many, which she shared freely with her community, friends and church. She loved music and learned to play several instruments. Her beautiful alto voice became part of her church choir, several trios and quartets.
