Trudy Sarvis, age 81, passed away Thursday, September 23, 2021.

Mrs. Sarvis was born in Horry County a daughter of the late Dewey and Eva Platt. She was a faithful and devoted member of Mt. Vernon Baptist Church and formerly a member of Sweet Home Baptist Church. At both churches, she volunteered and served in many roles. She was very active with the G.A.'s and was a founding leader of the Cub Scouts Pack 822 at Mt. Vernon. Mrs. Sarvis was also a member of the Order of the Eastern Star and, along with her husband, was a leader with the REACT team in Loris. She had a servant's heart and was always willing to help others in need. She volunteered her time crocheting caps for premature newborns and cancer patients.

She will also be remembered for her handmade greeting cards that she sent out every year by the hundreds. She also enjoyed cooking and was well known for her custom birthday and wedding cakes. Mrs. Sarvis loved to talk, never met a stranger, and was always devoted to her
