



Floyd Goodwin

November 27, 1934 - March 28, 2013

Conway, SC...Floyd Alister Goodwin age 78, died At Conway Medical Center, Thursday, March 28, 2013.

Mr. Goodwin was born in Walterboro, SC, the son of James Gordon Goodwin and the late Elizabeth Idella Blocker Goodwin.

He attended Wofford College in Spartanburg, S.C. and graduated with a B.S. degree in Chemistry in 1957 also receiving his second Lieutenant commission from Wofford in the U.S. Army. Floyd was stationed at Fort Monmouth, NJ.

Floyd's business career began at Clearwater Finishing Plant, United Merchants and Manufacturers in Clearwater, S.C. The family lived in North Augusta. Floyd and his family moved to Conway in 1976 and began the Lighthouse Christian Supply Inc. and some years later they also owned and operated Faith Bible Mart in Surfside Beach, S.C. Floyd was a member of First United Methodist Church in Conway S.C. since 1976. Floyd was an active Bible Scholar, Sunday school teacher, president of the church council, and other church organizations. Floyd also sang in the chancel choir for many years; was a Lay speaker in the Methodist Church, past member of the Kiwanas club, and an active member of the Gideons International where he served as president and held many other office positions. Floyd was a loving Husband to wife Louise of 56 years, loving father to Steve, Russell, and Alison and loving Papa to Sarah Hope.

Survivors are his wife Louise Cartrette Goodwin; two sons, John Steven Goodwin and wife Shelby of Conway, SC and James Russell Goodwin and

wife Sharon of Loris SC,; a daughter, Alison Elizabeth Goodwin of Conway, SC; a granddaughter, Sarah Hope Goodwin of Statesville, NC.

Services will be held 2:00 PM, Monday, April 1, 2013 at First United Methodist Church with Rev. Kyle Randle, Rev. Carl Harris and Rev. Nigel Scarborough officiating. Burial will follow at Lakeside Cemetery.

“ This is a story about Floyd from our Army experience. Grant Tate

Mom, Dad, and Warren came up to visit for a weekend during my tour at Ft. Monmouth, NJ. The base is near the Atlantic Ocean and in a part of New Jersey with many parks and recreation spots. On Sunday morning, we decided to visit one of those parks for a picnic. And we decided to also invite a couple Joyce and I had met on the base, Weezie and Floyd Goodwin from South Carolina. To celebrate my folk's visit, I purchased a gift for Warren, who was about 12 at the time—a boomerang.

The picnic area was at the edge of a huge grassy open field, bordered by a road connecting the park entrance to the picnic and other recreation areas. While the other's were preparing the picnic, Floyd, Warren and I went to the open field and practiced throwing the boomerang. We didn't have a lot of success getting the thing to return to us, but were interested to see the sweeping arcs the 14 inch plywood device made after being thrown with a snap of the arm.

After a while, Floyd and I returned to the picnic table while Warren continued to throw the boomerang farther and farther. On one of the throws, we looked up to see the wide arc of the boomerang sweeping toward the road on the periphery of the field and, to our shock to see a yellow Ford convertible, top-down driven by a young guy with a young woman, probably his girlfriend approaching. Oh, crap, I thought. That guy is driving right into the path of the boomerang. Please, God, don't let it hit him in the head. Clang! The boomerang collided with, not the guy's head, but the driver's side door. The guy brings the car to a halt, leaps out and heads right to Warren standing in the middle of the field. Floyd, my friend, was quick on the uptake and headed right for Warren, with my close behind. The Ford guy is shouting and screaming. We all come together in a loud group around Warren.

Floyd says, "Look soldier, we're sorry about that. You can see it was an accident. How about getting back in the car?" Floyd, noticing the driver's army dog tags and guessing he was an enlisted man, had moved into his officer's authority role as an officer. Now were were

off base, so we had little real authority over the Ford guy, but, heck, it worked.
