From 2016-2020 Becky also owned and operated a bed and breakfast called, "Becky's Place," in Murrells Inlet, SC. Becky loved meeting new people and never met a stranger. She made many long lasting friendships that she greatly cherished.

Becky was a member of Precious Blood Catholic Church in Pawleys Island, SC.

A celebration of life service will be held Monday, August 17th, 2020 at Precious Blood Catholic Church in Pawleys Island at 11:00 am.
