Frances Eilene Joice Hucks, age 91, wife of the late M/Sgt Jesse James Hucks, formerly of Myrtle Beach, died at the home of her Granddaughter in Beaufort, South Carolina, Thursday morning, after a long illness. Mrs. Hucks was born in Mott, North Dakota, June 20, 1913 the daughter of Sarah Berry Joice and Walter Cleveland Joice, and grew up in Leavenworth, Kansas. Frances and Jesse met and married at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, Jesse having left Conway in 1921 to join the Military. He was a survivor of the Bataan Death March, spending 36 months as a prisoner in the Philippines during WWII. Mrs. Hucks was a member of Carteret Street United Methodist Church, Beaufort and the Order of the Eastern Star, Lansing, Kansas. Surviving is her only child, Patsy Hucks Beaty and husband James Sloan Beaty of Bluffton, South Carolina, two Granddaughters, Peggy Beaty DuRant and husband Perry Walker DuRant of Beaufort, South Carolina, Janet Beaty Crabtree of Bluffton, South Carolina a Great Granddaughter, Leigh Hunter DuRant Hiers and husband Russell Scott Hiers of Hampton, South Carolina, and Great Grandson Perry Walker DuRant, Junior of Beaufort, South Carolina and a Great Great Grandson, Rylan Scott Hiers of Hampton, South Carolina.
