Frances Moore Hendrix, age 81, wife of the late Thomas "Tommie" M. Hendrix, died Friday, February 2, 2007 at Kingston Nursing Center following an illness. Mrs. Hendrix was born in Horry County, SC, the daughter of the late Walker Moore, Sr. and Goldie Averill Moore. Mrs. Hendrix started her career during WWII employed by Western Union in Charleston, SC, and later moved to Conway and was employed by the Field & Herald Newspaper. Later in life, she worked with Philip Sasser, helping to open his Law office as well as teaching furniture restoration at Horry Georgetown Technical College. In Mrs. Hendrix' last fifteen years of employment, she was the manager of Trader John's Antiques and Collectibles on Hwy 501 in Conway. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Conway, Conway Ladies Garden Club, and active as a Den Mother with the Cub Scouts.
