Frank Losee Chinery age 87, of Woodlake Village, died Sunday, March 4, 2012 at National Health Care.

Born in Bayonne, NJ he was the son of the late Viola and George M. Chinery. Mr. Chinery graduated from Cranford High School and attended Union Junior College in New Jersey. He served in the 9th Army during WWII. He was awarded the European African Middle eastern service medal with five battle stars; Ardennes, Central Europe, Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland. He was employed by AT&T for forty years followed by six years in communications for Merrill Lynch, then retired to this area in 1988. Mr. Chinery was an Elder of the Presbyterian Church and a member of the Murrells Inlet, SC church. He belonged to the telephone Pioneers of America and the VFW. He enjoyed golf and had an Amateur Radio License and enjoyed communicating around the world in Morse code. He was preceded in death by a brother, George Chinery.

He is survived by his wife, Dorothy Saunders Chinery; his son Gary Chinery and his wife Linda; his daughter, Victoria Knoblock and her husband Mark; and his son, Bruce Chinery and his wife Cara; four grandchildren, Sandra, Bruce Jr., Nadia and Olivia and a brother, Wilbur Chinery of Murrells Inlet.
