Frank Rotolo, 70, of Conway and formerly of New York, passed away at his home on Sunday, December 31, 2023, with his loving family by his side. Later in his professional career, Frank was a proud New York City sanitation worker. He was also a responder during the September 11th terrorist attack on the World Trade Center. Frank was the type of person who would give the shirt off his back to someone in need. He also loved to bust people's chops and make everyone laugh, even during the worst circumstances.

Frank is survived by his loving and devoted family, including his beloved wife of 36 years, Donna Rotolo; his two sons who were his pride and joy, Frankie

Jr. and Michael Rotolo; his sister Linda Jackson and her husband James; his sister Cathy Berg and her husband Benjamin; his brother Anthony Rotolo; as well as countless other extended family members and many friends, all who will forever cherish his memory.

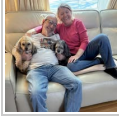
