Frederick Brown McNulty, age 74, died Tuesday, October 18, 2005, at his residence following an illness. Born on February 3, 1931 in Boston, Mass. the third son of the late Cyrus James and Irene Thursa Brown McNulty. Mr. McNulty graduated from high school then joined the Navy, serving for four years during the Korean War.
