November 16, 1924 - February 1, 2014

Frederick I. Erasmus, age 89, died on Saturday February 1, 2014 at his residence.

Frederick was a son of the late Charles Ignatius Erazmus and Anna Gawlak Erazmus. He was born in Meriden, CT. Frederick was a retired fireman and a US Navy veteran on the USS Princeton Aircraft Carrier CVL-23, sunk in the Pacific Ocean. He was a member of St. Michael Catholic Church, and the American Legion Murrells Inlet. Frederick was a Washington Redskins fan. He was preceded by 11 brothers and sisters.
