



Frederick Edward Jackson

December 13, 1940 - December 14, 2022

On Wednesday, December 14th, 2022, our beloved father Frederick Edward Jackson passed away peacefully.

Fred Jackson was born on December 13th, 1940 in Baltimore Maryland to Mr. Edward Jackson and Mrs. Beatrice Shorter Jackson. He was the oldest of three boys. Fred attended Mt. Saint Joseph's High School in Baltimore and joined the U.S. Air Force in the fall of 1961. He served admirably for 22 years and retired in 1984 at the rank of Master Sergeant. Fred was a veteran of the Vietnam Campaign and received numerous citations during this time. While enlisted, he also served two tours of duty in Germany. Upon his retirement from the Air Force, Fred went to work for Myrtle Beach Farms and worked at the Myrtle Beach Pavilion. While working there, he attended Horry-Georgetown Technical College and received an Associates Degree in Electrical Engineering.

Fred Jackson had numerous hobbies that included fishing, NASCAR racing, and model railroading. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, and the Grand Strand model railroaders club. Fred attended and was a member of St. James Catholic Church in Conway, S.C.

Frederick Jackson was preceded in death by his parents Edward and Beatrice Jackson, his brother Francis Jack Jackson, his ex-wife Pearl Jackson, and his

wife Maria Jackson. He is survived by his brother Robert Jackson and his wife Carolyn of Baltimore, M.D., his son Mark Jackson and his wife Kimberlee Jackson of Myrtle Beach, S.C., his daughter Amy Jackson of Nichols, S.C., his daughter Melissa Hardee and her husband James Hardee of Conway, S.C., his grandsons Nathan and Matthew Jackson, and his granddaughter Maria Jackson.

A viewing will be held on Tuesday, December, 20th from 11:00am-Noon at St. James Catholic Church at 1071 Academy Drive (off Hwy 501) in Conway S.C. A funeral mass will be held immediately after.
