
Frederick Ronald Weber age 83, devoted husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather, died Monday, March 11, 2013 at Conway Medical Center. Born in New Brunswick, NJ, he was a son of the late Frederick A. and Estelle Smith Weber. Mr. Weber was a U.S. Navy veteran of the Korean War from 1951-1955 aboard the USS Robert K. Huntington. He retired a Lt. from the police department in 1986 after working with the New Brunswick, New Jersey police since 1956. Mr. Weber was a member of the Tin Can Sailors and a lifetime member of the Elks #324 in New Brunswick, NJ and the Police Benevolence Association Local #23.
