The family will receive friends from 5-7 PM Friday at the funeral home.

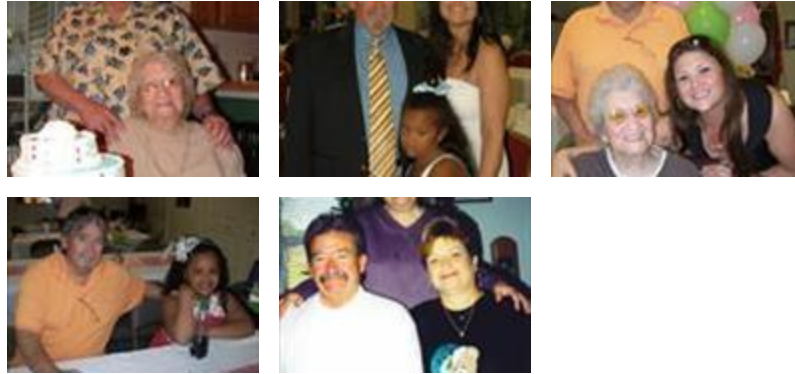

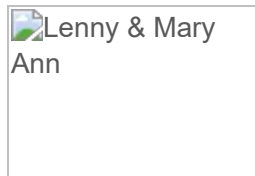
