Gary Robinson age 68, died Wednesday, June 20, 2012 after a 5 year battle with Lung Cancer at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Born in Gastonia, NC, he was a son of the late John and Artie Lee Robinson. Mr. Robinson was a U.S. Air Force veteran. He worked in various Textile Mills for 30 years.
