George B. Fagan, Jr., of Surfside Beach, SC (formerly from West Orange, NJ and Chester Township, NJ) passed at the age of 82 with his wife and daughter by his side. He was president of the New Jersey Personnel and Guidance Association and co-editor of the NJAC newsletter for 12 years. Mr. Fagan was a football official in the NJFOA for 35 years and a high school lacrosse official in NJILOA for 25 years.

George had a love for University of South Carolina football and the Green Bay Packers. George lived a life that influenced many people through his words and wisdom. He was an enthusiastic and energetic Pop Pop. One of his greatest passions was his love for his family and friends.
