April 18, 1944 - September 11, 2012

George A. Yeager age 68, died Tuesday, September 11, 2012 at his residence.

Born in Camden, NJ, he was the son of the late Rudolph and Mary Siefert Yeager. He attended high school at Audubon High School graduating in 1963. Mr. Yeager was a US Air Force veteran where he served as a jet engine mechanic and served in Vietnam in 1968-1969. He was a member of American Legion Post 178, American Legion Riders, the Patriot Guard, and RSES-CM. He was licensed in heating and air conditioning and was Nate certified. He was part owner of A-Air Conditioning in Myrtle Beach.


