Geraldine Bell Williams age 92, died Thursday, March 7, 2013 at Tideland's Community Hospice House.

Born in Monterey, PA, she was a daughter of the late Samuel H. and Nellie Foringer. Geraldine grew up in Craigsville, PA and was a 1938 graduate of Worthington West Franklin High School, in Worthington, PA. 
