Gertrude Amanda Wooten Zachary, of Myrtle Beach, passed into eternity to be with her Husband, Jack Zachary, on Sunday, January 26, 2020. Memorial Services will be held on Friday, January 31, at 3:00 pm, at Socastee United Methodist Church.

Gertrude was born in Harmony N.C. on June 4, 1929, as the daughter of Marvin Wooten and Mary Harbin Wooten. She was preceded in death by her older brother, Jack Wooten and has two surviving sisters, Evelyn Webb & Nancy Poore, and one younger brother, Bobby Wooten and his wife, Agnes.
