Glennie Morgan Walsh age 84, died Monday, March 10, 2014 at her residence.

Born in Forsyth County, NC, she was a daughter of the late Hampton and Myrtle Morgan. Mrs. Walsh graduated from Mineval Springs High School in Winston Salem in 1947. She attended Salem College School of Music. She lived in Mt. Airy, NC for 51 years and retired from Bank of America. She had given 900 hours of volunteer service to Northern Surry Hospital. She moved to Murrells Inlet, SC in 2004. She was a member of Belin Memorial United Methodist Church where she served and was very active with the choir, the singles group, sanctuary Sunday school class, the seniors group and was an Endowment Committee volunteer. Mrs. Walsh was also involved with the Beginners Bridge and was a charter member of the Serendipity Singers serving on board as a secretary.
