Prior to retirement, she was employed by Conway Hospital for 26 years and founded the first recovery room for the hospital. She was a member of First Baptist Church of Conway and the Dorcas Sunday School Class.

Surviving are one son, Major John T. Duckett, III, US Army Retired, and wife, Julia of Plymouth, Indiana; and two daughters, Elaine Magann Sarvis and husband Mack of Pawleys Island, SC and Dr. Jean C. Duckett of Conway; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
