Guy Osborne, Jr. age 69, died Saturday, June 27, 2015 in Washington, VA on the Creeper bike trail.

Born in Union, SC, he was a son of the late Guy and Rebecca Osborne. Guy was a retired Horry County police department Captain. He also retired from the Pawleys Island as a Police Chief. He was the owner of Chief Big Daddy's boot camp and a member of FOP. Guy was preceded in death by his daughter Rhonda "Sissy" O'Shields and his granddaughter Stacey "Popie" O'Shields. Survivors include his wife of 50 years, Betty Osborne of Myrtle Beach; a son, Scott Osborne (Torie Waddell) of Conway; daughter Rebecca Osborne of Myrtle Beach; grandsons, Dylan Osborne and Justin O'Shields; granddaughter, Brookelyn Postlewait; sisters, Hassie Mae Vaughn of Union, Brenda Dubnik of MD; brothers, James "Jimmy" Osborne of Union and Tommy "Oz" Osborne of MD.
