Guy Anthony Pastrana Sr., 72, entered into the presence of the Lord while sleeping in the early hours of Thursday, October 9th 2025 in Conway, South Carolina. Guy was born on September 1st 1953 in the Bronx, New York to Anthony Joseph and Melvina Rose Pastrana.

After graduating from high school in New York, Guy attended Richard Stockton State College (now Stockton University) in Galloway Township, New Jersey and later continued his education at Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Guy proudly served as a police officer for over two decades in several municipalities across southern New Jersey including Millville, Hamilton Township, Pleasantville, and Linwood. As a police officer, Guy worked undercover and as a traffic motorcycle officer, among other assignments.
