Harlan LuVerne Schuett age 76, passed away on Wednesday, October 20, 2021.

Born in Storm Lake, Iowa, he was a son of the late LuVerne Harlan and Elizabeth Schuett. Harlan retired honorably after serving 28 years active duty in the U.S. Marine Corps, following a career encapsulating 3 tours of duty during the Vietnam War. He held many positions including Recruiter and Drill Instructor. He ended his career with the rank of Sergeant Major in the position of Lead Recruiter. After his military retirement he worked at the United States Postal Service for 18 years. Harlan also helped with the 'Young Marines' organization in Nashville, TN.
