



## Harmon Dock Graham

June 12, 1934 - February 7, 2024

Harmon Dock Graham, age 89 passed away Wednesday, February 7, 2024 at his home on the Waccamaw River surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Horry County on June 12, 1934, a son of the late Dock Harmon and Sallie Shelley Graham. In addition to his parents, Harmon was predeceased by his wife Betty Ann McCall Graham; by three brothers; Wildo Graham, Russell Graham, and Lonnie Graham; six sisters; Ethel Johnson, Betty Jane Hilburn, Georgia Fowler, Rose Lee Stroud, Nanie Graham and Flosie Ray.

In 2007 Harmon gave his life to the Lord and was a member of Forestbrook Baptist Church.
