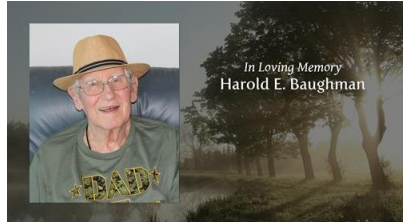

“ I first met Mr. Baughman back in 1986 when I was nine years old. It was a thrill for this elementary school kid when he offered me a part in the high school musical that he was directing. He and his colleague from the music department, the late Carsten "Jon" Ahrens (1942-2020) made a great team as they produced *South Pacific*.
