Harold P. Moore Dateline: Georgetown Harold P. Moore, age 91, of Debordieu, died Saturday, September 18, 2010 at Georgetown Memorial Hospital. Born in Philadelphia, PA he was a son of the late Robert Louis and Lucy Mortimer Moore. Mr. Moore graduated from Collingdale High School. He was also a graduate of the University of SC class of 1941. He was the owner and operator of State Auto Paint Company in Columbia for 50 years. Mr. Moore was a watercolor artist, was a member of the SC Watercolor Society, and won many national shows. He served on the SC Arts Commission and was a member of the Wednesday group at St. Peters Lutheran Church in Pawleys Island. His love of helping was fulfilled by his involvement with Smile Train and teaching art at Teach My People Christian Youth Center in Pawleys Island. Mr. Moore was a former member for over 50 years at Columbia First Baptist Church. After moving to Georgetown, he became an active member of the Pawleys Island Community Church. Survivors include his wife of 69 years, Josephine Bailey Moore; sons, Kenneth Moore and his wife Jan of Georgetown, SC, David Moore and his wife Valerie of Columbia, SC; daughters, Elaine Whisnant and her husband Wayne of Swansea, SC; Linda Hook and her husband George of Rock Hill, SC; eleven grandchildren; eleven great grandchildren; and four great-great grandchildren. He will always be remembered for loving life, his family, friends, art, church and the Gamecocks. Funeral services will be held 11:00 AM Tuesday, September 21, 2010 at Pawleys Island Community Church with Reverend Don Williams officiating.
