Mr. Harry "Buddy" Freeman, age 74, passed away on Friday, May 27, 2022 at MUSC.

Born September 5, 1947 in Beaufort, SC, he was the son of the late Harry Freeman, Jr. and the late Frances Ferguson Freeman. Mr. Freeman graduated with his undergraduate degree from Georgia Southwestern and with a master's degree in Education from Winthrop University.

He proudly served his community as a member of Keep Horry County Beautiful, Waccamaw River Keepers, and the Children's Mentoring Program of Horry County.

Mr. Freeman was a former member of Kingston Presbyterian and attended Westminster Presbyterian Church. He retired from Horry County School Systems after working as a teacher, administrator, and coach.

Mr. Freeman enjoyed reading, but most of all, playing with his grandchildren.

Along with his parents, he was predeceased by three sisters, Linda Kay Phleger, Nancy Freeman, and Fran Freeman.
