Harvey E. Kilmer, Jr., age 75, passed away Wednesday, March 17, 2021 at his home in Loris, SC.

Mr. Kilmer was born May 26, 1945 in Mt. Kisco, NY. He resided in Dover Plains, NY for most of his life and spent winters in South Carolina. Mr. Kilmer worked with Taconic DDSO for 30 years retiring in 2006.
