Henry "Buster" Elting Holliday, Jr., age 62, died January 3, 2007 at his home after a lengthy illness. Mr. Holliday was born in Florence, SC, June 21, 1944, a son of Margaret Payne Holliday and the late Henry E. Holliday, Sr. and grandson of the late Frances Grissette and Annie Epps Holliday of Horry County, SC. He graduated from Conway High School and the University of South Carolina. He was a veteran of the United States Army, and served at Fort Meade, Maryland, and Cheltenham, England. Mr. Holliday was employed by Honeywell and NCR Corporation for several years as a Systems Analyst.
