Henry George King Myrtle Beach Henry George King age 93, died Wednesday, January 28, 2009. Mr. King was born in Huntington WV and earned a bachelors degree in journalism from Marshall University. He was a reporter and news editor for The Huntington Herald Dispatch and one of his fondest memories was having the opportunity to interview first lady Eleanor Roosevelt. In 1952 he moved to Charleston WV and worked for the United Fuel Gas Company, where he eventually served as director of public relations, later moving to Columbus OH where he served as director of education services for the company. He was a past president of Charleston WV Kiwanis Club, is named on the Marshall University School of Journalism Wall of Fame, and was a three time board member of the Marshall University Alumni Association. He and his wife retired to Myrtle Beach in 1981, where they made many new friends in Deerfield Plantation and later at Covenant Towers. He was a member of Surfside United Methodist Church. Survivors include his wife of 68 years Marian Snyder King of Myrtle Beach; his daughters, Carolyn Larry Walker of Atlanta, GA and Joanne Tom Langfitt of Myrtle Beach; his brother, Roger Glennith King of Mesa, AZ; grandsons, David Walker of Long Island, NY, Andrew Walker of Nashville, TN, Bill Langfitt of Myrtle Beach and Jim Langfitt of Miami FL and three great grandchildren.
