Conway...Henry H. Holmes, age 90, passed away Sunday, October 16, 2011 at McLeod Regional Medical Center in Florence.

Mr. Holmes was born on February 11, 1921 in the Red Bluff Community, a son of the late Daniel and Lola Todd Holmes. He lived most of his life in his beloved Horry County.
