



Henry S. Yarborough Sr.

April 10, 1922 - September 16, 2017

Rev. Henry Samuel Yarborough, Sr., 95, of Myrtle Beach, died Saturday, September 16, 2017, at Myrtle Beach Manor. Born in Woodsdale, NC, he was the son of the late Willie Henry and Alma Barnett Yarborough. A veteran of World War II, he proudly served in the 84th Infantry of the U.S. Army in Europe from 1942-1945, earning many honors and medals, including the Bronze Star and Purple Heart.

Rev. Yarborough graduated from Campbell Junior College, Wake Forest College, and Southeastern Theological Seminary. During his 68 years of ministry, he served as pastor to churches in both North Carolina and South Carolina, locally serving in Good Hope Baptist Church and Jamestown Baptist Church, Conway, SC. He was a member of Jamestown Baptist Church having served there as Minister for 16 years, and as Pastor Emeritus.

He is survived by his five children: Marsha Y. Nobles and husband Pat of NMB, SC, Rev. Henry S. Yarborough, Jr. and wife Linda of Simpsonville, SC, Darlene Y. Holmes of Conway, SC, Karen Y. Alexander and husband Bob of Little River, SC, and Debbie Y. Walters and husband Karl of Longs, SC. Rev. Yarborough is also survived by his ten grandchildren, 23 great-grandchildren, and his sister Esther Banna Clayton of Roxboro, NC.

Rev. Yarborough was predeceased by his wife of 56 years, Jessiemine M. Yarborough, his parents, three sisters, one brother and son-in-law Jimmy E. Holmes, Sr.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 20, 2017,

at Jamestown Baptist Church in Conway, SC. Entombment will follow at the Hillcrest Cemetery Chapel Mausoleum, Conway, directed by Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel.

The family will receive friends from 6:00-8:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 19, 2017, at the funeral home.

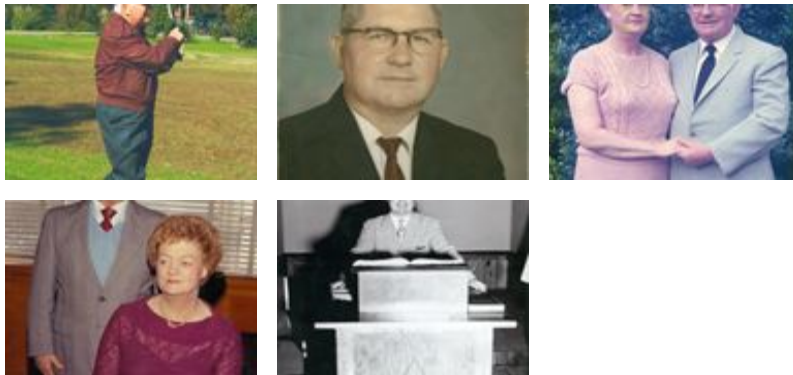
