Herbert Anglo Timmons, Jr. age 78, loving husband, father, grandfather and friend, died Sunday, November 8, 2015 at Waccamaw Community Hospital. Born in Lake City, SC, he was a son of the late Treva and Herbert Timmons, Sr. Mr. Timmons graduated from Lake City High School in 1955 and from The Citadel in 1959. He was a U.S. Army veteran who served in Korea. He worked with IGA Wholesalers in Lake City, SC and owned and operated Fender Menders in Myrtle Beach and helped start the Fender Menders in Charleston and Mt. Pleasant, SC. Mr. Timmons was a member of Belin Memorial United Methodist Church and was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
