Herman Alexander Overcash, Jr., age 79, of Pawleys Island, SC passed away on December 29, 2021 surrounded by his family and friends.

He was born to parents, Herman and Bonnie Overcash on December 10, 1942 in Charlotte, North Carolina. Herman graduated from North Mecklenburg High School and received a degree in mechanical engineering from N.C. State University.
