Myrtle Beach...Hope Tallevast Stalvey Godefroy, 95, of Myrtle Beach, died Saturday, March 22, 2014.

Mrs. Godefroy was born to the late Harry W. and Sadie Eaddy Tallevast April 23, 1918, in Georgetown, SC. She was a graduate of Conway High School and Coker College. Mrs. Godefroy was married to the late Allan Eugene "Gene" Stalvey, who died in 1956. She married the late Hugh C. Godefroy, M.D. in 1962 and they spent 40 wonderful years together until his death in 2002. Mrs. Godefroy was proud of her family and heritage. Having lived the majority of her life in Horry County and the daughter of a former mayor of Myrtle Beach, she was often asked to talk about the early days of Myrtle Beach, Georgetown and Conway. She was a proud member of the Huguenot Society of South Carolina and the Horry County Historical Society.

She is further survived by her constant companion and caregiver for fifty years, Betty Davis of Conway, SC.
