During a lifelong career at Westinghouse Corp. he designed components for nuclear submarines and aircraft carriers. He was very proud to be at the christening of the USS Nimitz. He retired to Myrtle Beach in 1983 to enjoy many years of golf, travel and mission work through Surfside United Methodist Church. Howard was preceded in death by his first wife, the mother of his children, Margaret Baltzer and his second wife, Dee whom he met at Christ United Methodist Church where he was a member for 30 years. A memorial service will be held at 11:00 AM Saturday, November 8, 2014 at Surfside United Methodist Church.

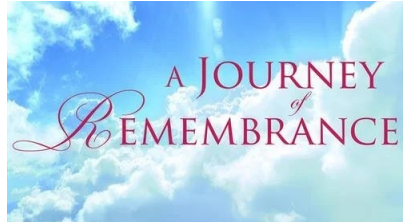
