



## Howard Lee

June 10, 1932 - August 30, 2013

Conway...Howard D. Lee, age 81, of Lakeside Drive, died Friday, August 30, 2013 at Conway Medical Center.

Mr. Lee was born in Horry County, a son of the late Dock Davis and Annie Bell Thompkins Lee. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Conway where he served as chairman of the Ushers for 12 years. Mr. Lee was a U.S. Air Force Veteran and retired after 31 years of service with Nabisco Inc. He was a member and Past Master of Horry Masonic Lodge # 381. Mr. Lee was a past member of the Conway City Council, the Conway Jaycees and the Horry Georgetown Tech. Commission. He was a baseball and softball umpire for 25 years and was a coach for the 1969 Dixie Youth State Champions. Mr. Lee worked the 1987 USSSA World Series in Waterloo, Iowa and was inducted into the South Carolina USSSA Softball Hall of Fame as an umpire. He was predeceased by one sister, Isla Mae Welch and three brothers, Jesse M. Lee, D.D. Lee, Jr and J. Archie Lee.

Surviving are his wife, Peggy Lee of Conway, one son, Tim Lee (Angela) and their son, Jayson, all of Conway, four sisters, Allene Rodden of Winston Salem, NC, Virginia Davis (Lloyd) and Frances Ward, all of Conway and Shirley Burroughs of Columbia.

Funeral services will be held at 4:00 PM Sunday at First Baptist Church with Dr. Robert Guffey and Rev. Rocky Taylor officiating. Entombment with Masonic Rites will follow at Hillcrest Mausoleum.

The family will receive friends from 3:00 PM until 4:00 PM Sunday at the

church.
