Hubert F. "Bert" Rawls age 84, passed away Saturday, March 9, 2013 at Grand Strand Healthcare.

Born in Waycross, GA, he was a son of the late Hubert Fields and Louise Robert Rawls. Bert retired from the U. S. Air Force as a Special Agent with the Office of Special Investigations where his case load included both criminal and counter intelligence cases. He continued his career as a Special Agent with the Departments of Housing and Urban Development and Health and Human Services. His special interest was in training and mentoring young new agents. Bert served as an Admissions Representative for Georgia Military College (GMC), was on the Board of Trustees of the GMC Foundation and a member of the GMC Oak Leaf Society. He also served as a Board Member of the Children's Mentoring Program in Conway. He was preceded in death by a son, John Christopher and 3 sisters, Eugenia, Dorothy and Ann.

Survivors include his wife, Nancy Speight Rawls of Myrtle Beach; a son, James S. Rawls (Julie) of Little Rock, AR; daughters, Eugenia Beattie (George) of Atlanta, GA, Alice Kramer (Craig) of South China, ME and Theresa Lynn Rawls (Ron) of Cochise, AR; a brother, Pete Rawls of Fernandina Beach, FL; 5 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 10:00 AM Thursday, March 14, 2013 at St. Michael Catholic Church with Father Raymond Carlo officiating.
