She worked several years at Fair Bluff Body Shop as an estimator, Doug Long's Body Shop (Loris), and Gateway Ford (Conway) as the first lady body shop foreman and estimator. She later worked at Red Bluff Body Shop as estimator and office manager alongside her husband, Johnnie.

Mrs. Bullock also worked with her special friend, Buddy Cox, at Southland Nursery and Landscaping for many years.

She cherished her family and will be remembered as a caring and devoted wife, mother, grandmother, sister, and friend.

Along with her parents, Mrs. Bullock was predeceased by her husband, Johnnie McNeil Bullock, a daughter, Mary Fields Carter, a son, David Bullock, three brothers, Rudolph Rabon, Donald Rabon, and Boyd Rabon, one sister, Willie Jo Tyree, and two infant grandsons David Fields and Bobby Strickland.
