J. Darryl Ray, age 41, of Primrose Court, formerly of Fayetteville, NC, died Saturday, June 25, 2005 at East Cooper Regional Medical Center in Mt. Pleasant, SC from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. Mr. Ray was born in Erwin, NC, a son of J. Stanley and Hilda "Nancy" Ammons Ray. He was a member of Carolina Forest Community Church and was employed with Coca-Cola Bottling Company for twenty-two years. 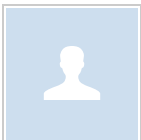
