June 21, 1932 - March 28, 2021

Jack Everett Arnold of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina died at the age of 88 on Sunday, March 28, 2021 at the Grand Strand Medical Center. He was born on June 21, 1932 in Waycross, Georgia. He lived in that area in his youth and attended local schools. Jack is survived by his wife of 52 years, Brigitte A. Arnold, daughter Donna and her husband Kenny and family, daughter Deanna Carrol and her husband Ken and family. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Denise Counts, and several half-brothers and a sister.

As a young man he joined the U.S. Army and went on to have a 22 year career. He served in the Korean and Vietnam wars and retired in 1974. He then started a second career as a Department of Defense civilian employee working in logistics management as a supply systems analyst.

In 1992 he suffered a massive stroke in connection to his military service. As a result he retired from public service. The condition led the Veterans Affairs to determine he was 100 percent disabled. He was wheel chair bound for 28 years. In the years after his stroke Jack was able to rebuild his daily activities with the support of his devoted wife. He did that with determination and grit and went on to lead a productive life with the support of his wife, family, and dedicated care givers.

A memorial service is scheduled for April 2, 2021 at 1 pm followed by burial at
