



## Jacob Bieger

December 23, 1922 - May 30, 2014

Dateline: Pawleys Island

Jacob John Bieger, age 91, of Mackinley Circle, died Friday, May 30, 2014 at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Mr. Bieger was born in Hoboken, NJ and was a son of the late Hugo and Mary Bieger. He was a US Navy veteran serving in the Pacific Theatre during WWII as a Seabee. Mr. Bieger moved to Pawleys Island, SC after retiring from a career in bookbinding 20 years ago. He was a member of Precious Blood of Christ Catholic Church where he was also a volunteer. Mr. Bieger was a 4th degree Knight of Columbus member, volunteer at Waccamaw Hospital, and a volunteer at the Pawleys Island library where he repaired books.

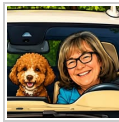
