James Peter Cannon age 82, died Sunday, June 9, 2013 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was a son of the late Peter and Mary Cannon. Mr. Cannon was a 1948 graduate of Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia, PA.
