James "Jay" Cobbett age 84, died Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Born in Scottdale, PA, he was a son of the late Joseph Alvin and Isola Mae Cobbett. Jay was a high school graduate of Irwin High School in Irwin, PA. He moved from Pennsylvania to Ohio and worked for Euclio Road Machinery December 1952 until 1953 when they were bought by General Motors and then he worked for Euclid Division GM, Euclio Ohio until 1974 when it became Terex Division GM Hudson Ohio and he worked until November 30, 1982 when he took early retirement when GM sold to a German holding company, IBH. Jay then worked as a consultant and foreign trade representative with Cleveland Port Authority from April 1983 until June 1987. He moved to Murrells Inlet, SC August 10 1987 and worked as a security guard from Wachesaw Plantation from January 1988 until May 1996. He also worked patrolling Wachesaw East Plantation during its initial development phase June 1995 until May 1996 at which time he then was security supervisor for Wachesaw Plantation East. He was respectfully and affectionately known by his residents as "Mr. Jay" their friendly smiling security officer who loved people and golf.

Survivors include his wife, Darla S. Cobbett of Murrells Inlet; a son, Michael J. Cobbett of Willoughby, OH; a granddaughter, Andrea Cobbett and a great grandson Andre Michael Cobbett both of OH; a sister, Mae L. Warnock and a

brother-in-law, Edward of Willoughby, OH; mother-in-law, Carlene Tyrerell of Cuyahoga Falls, OH and brother and sister-in-law, David A and Crystal L. Seffen of Southern Pines, NC.
