James Bryant Crawford, age 94, passed away Saturday, December 20, 2025.

Mr. Crawford was born in Conway, a son of the late James Edwin Crawford and the late Lutie Mae Alford Crawford. He retired from the U.S. Air Force where he was stationed all over the world, including India, Greece, Turkey, Germany, Italy, and the Philippines. Mr. Crawford was a licensed pilot for private aircraft and was a lifetime member of the Experimental Aircraft Association.

He was a member of North Conway Baptist Church and also volunteered with Churches Assisting People. Mr. Crawford was a motorcycle enthusiast and an avid hunter and fisherman. He had a wonderful sense of humor and loved music, especially Bluegrass. In his youth, Mr. Crawford worked as a sharecropper's field hand before entering the service. He will be most remembered as a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his wife, Nina Rea Crawford; three brothers; and two sisters.

Survivors include his three sons, Larry Bryant Crawford (Debra) of Galivants Ferry, Warren Keith Crawford (Stephanie) of Aynor, and Robin Dean Crawford (Pamela) of Goose Creek; two grandchildren, Sara Lynn Spivey (Bryan) of Myrtle Beach and Tina Lynn Grooms (Steven) of Summerville; four great grandchildren, Robert Cole Grooms, Brooke Lynn Grooms, Stephanie Michelle Grooms all of Summerville, and Luke Braydon Spivey of Myrtle Beach; one sister, Jimmie Mae Norton of Green Sea; and one brother, Jim Collins of Loris.
