J. Jack Jordan Litchfield Beach J. Jack Jordan age 89, passed away Wednesday, August 12, 2009 at Tideland Community Hospice House. Mr. Jordan was born on September 8, 1919 in Salisbury, NC, a son of the late J.J. Jordan and Verona Loflin Jordan. Jack was active in the Theatre Business throughout his life. In Raleigh, NC he served as City Manager of ABC's 5 Theatres. He became Director of Advertising for ABC Southeastern Theatres in Charlotte and remained in that position until he joined the late Foster Mckissick as Advertising Director of his Litchfield Theatres, moving to Litchfield Beach. During his career, Jack worked with many Celebrities. During WWII he chaired numerous War Bond Drives bringing Bob Hope, Betty Grable and other stars to the Carolinas. He promoted several movie premieres, working with Roy Rogers, John Payne, Patrick Neal and Charlton Heston, Myrtle Beach Sun Fun Festivals with Slim Pickens and Sharon Tate. After retirement, Jack enjoyed his hobbies of playing cards and golf. He was a member of St. Paul's Waccamaw United Methodist Church. He was preceded in death by his sister, Margaret J. McCanless and brothers, William Sanford Jordan and Charles Sylvester Jordan. Jack is survived by his wife, Carolyn G. Jordan of the home; daughters, Diane J. Taylor and S. Lanyoex Jordan; grandsons, D. Brian Taylor and Jonathan J. Florea all of Charlotte, NC; also surviving are stepchildren, James Martin, Scott Martin, Rebecca M. Tyndal and Nancy M. Smith. The family will have a visitation from 3:00-5:00 PM Saturday, August 15, 2009 at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel.
